MARBLE CARE

General Cleaning

Mild dish soap & water are your friends! Use a mixture of the two for your general cleaning using a soft sponge or dishcloth. You can also use neutral natural stone cleaners as well.

Heavy detergent cleaners & acids are not recommended with marble as they can etch/damage the stone and it's finish.

Remember - acids from fruit juices/foods can etch marble.

Stain Care

Stains can be stubborn!

Marble can be susceptible to stains if dark liquids (coffee/wine/juice) are spilled and not cleaned up promptly.

Baking Soda - can be mixed into a paste, set over your stain, then cover the mixture with plastic wrap (tape around edges, poke some holes in it). Leave for 48 hours to help pull stains out.

Professional-grade poultice mixes are available, as well.

Oops!

Clean up your spills quickly to minimize spotting & stains.

Sealing

Marble countertops need to be sealed once a year. The life of your sealer depends upon the cleaners that you use. Ensure you test your natural stone bi-yearly to ensure your sealer is holding up.

Spritz water on your stone - if the water beads up - your sealer is working! If not - it's time to reseal!

Treatments

Technicians are available for cracks/chips or if your marble is dull and needing a lift from a deep clean & a fresh coat of sealer.
